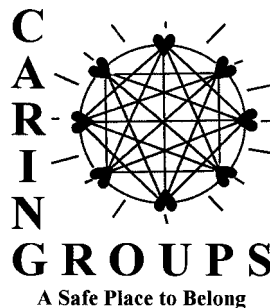

Good Morning! We are so glad that you have chosen to gather with Danforth Community Church today. We pray that this service will have a powerful impact on your life. Here is a brief description of our worship service, which hopefully will help you to feel more “at home.”

Our worship service, based on the pattern of Psalm 95, includes joyful celebration, intimate worship and an opportunity to hear and respond to the Word of God. During our worship service, which usually lasts about 2 hours, we often stand and sing for extended periods of time. If you find this uncomfortable, please be seated at any time. Just before the sermon children (JK to Grade 6) will be invited to go downstairs for Superchurch. A staffed nursery, located on the lower floor, is available for children ages 3 and under throughout the entire service.

Most services include a “ministry time” in which people are invited to come to the front for special prayer. If you have needs in your life we invite you to receive ministry at this time.

We celebrate communion once a month. You do not have to be a member of this church to participate. If you know Jesus as your personal Saviour, you are encouraged to participate as we remember the death and resurrection of our Lord.
